Build Bridges, Not Walls' for which we are welcoming submissions for abstracts. DRC will be taking place on 28–29 May 2020 in the building of the Pontifical University of John Paul II in Krakow at 3 Bernardyńska Street.

The Doctoral Research Conference 2020 (DRC 2020) will be an interdisciplinary meeting of doctoral students and young scientists who want to share the results of their research or projects, ranging from humanities to hard science. Our conference will provide a unique environment for the exchange of thoughts between historians and biotechnologists, artists and physicists, philosophers and mathematicians, theologians and computer scientists.

As the organisers of DRC 2020 we offer a two-day academic event. The first day, 28 May, will be devoted to sharing the results of academic research. Contributios should be as follows: **Research Paper, Panel Discussion, Research Film, Research Poster**. You are encouraged to choose whichever format is most convenient for presenting the results of your research. Imagination is the only limit.

At the end of the first day of our conference, you are invited to a jazz concert. The second day of the conference, 29 May, is time to relax and unwind. A day will be devoted to social integration activities. Board games, city games, Krakow guided tours, as well as Cuban dance workshops are on offer.

The aim of DRC 2020 is to **share research perspectives in the English language** in a way that is understandable and straightforward for a wider audience, bearing in mind that attendants will be researchers coming from all over Poland and from abroad as well, and from diverse scientific fields. We are interested in research from all disciplines and all time periods: from the past to the present day. The idea being to deepen our understanding of modern man and ultimate reality. The purpose of the conference is to provide a friendly space for sharing scientific reflections and research experiences, as well as a great opportunity for developing new interpersonal connections.
