



### INFORMATION FOR OUR EXCHANGE PARTNERS

As we expect ERASMUS+ students from all over Europe, we would like to inform you about our university's precautions and measures regarding the COVID-19 pandemic. Below you can find answers to some of the most frequently asked questions and concerns.

## SITUATION FOR NEW INCOMING ERASMUS+ STUDENTS

#### **Current situation**

At present, we still expect our exchange programme to go ahead as it has been planned. Please be advised, however, that teaching activities, including preparatory language classes, are suspended and libraries are closed until 25 March 2020 (for now). Uniwersytet Papieski Jana Pawła II w Krakowie bases its measures on the recommendations of the Information of the Chief Sanitary Inspector for tertiary education institutions regarding the potential risk of coronavirus infection. The city of Krakow has issued a decree prohibiting gatherings of more than 50 people. People are advised to stay home and limit contact to others as much as possible. So far, there have been three confirmed cases in the whole city.

# Preparations before arrival

Students should take note of entry and exit regulations for Poland and their home countries. For questions concerning courses and alternative teaching activities, students should contact their departmental coordinators. A list with the contact information of all coordinators is attached.

Please also note that our office is closed for the public, although we are still available via e-mail and phone. Students who wish to cancel their mobility must do so by March 30rd 2020, via e-mail to <a href="mailto:erasmus@upjp2.edu.pl">erasmus@upjp2.edu.pl</a>





Students from high-risk areas or students who travel through high-risk areas should take precautions and self-isolate for two weeks upon arrival in Krakow.
